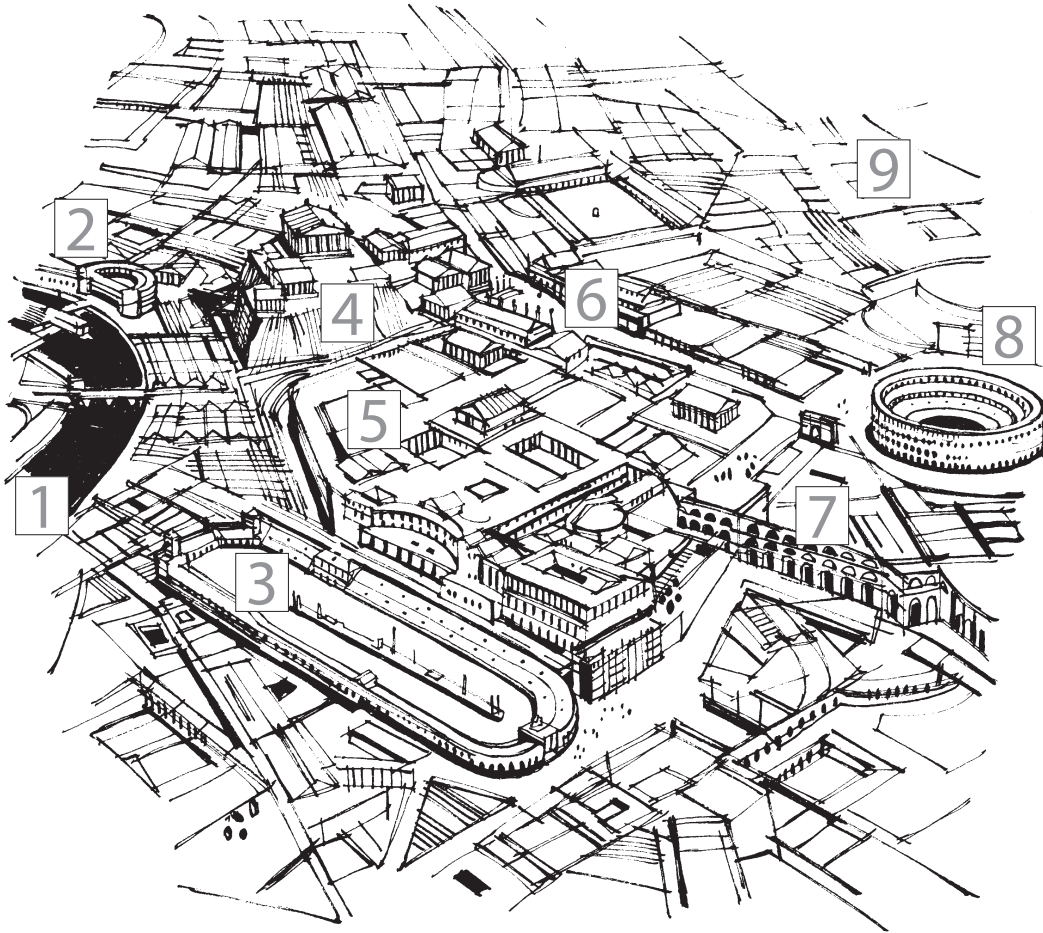


## A bird's-eye view of Rome
